Intermediate skill level

For the experienced quilter looking for more challenging Log Cabin designs that use logs cut on 45 or 60 degree angles. You will learn how to cut and piece Flavin's tumbling block and various diamond and triangular log cabin blocks. You will learn steps to improve piecing accuracy and will plan a color scheme on the provided design grids.
