### DISCOVERY OF THE CEDAR HEIGHTS PLANTATION QUILT COLLECTION

Flavin Glover's slide narrative chronicles four generations of quiltmakers, set on a lovely plantation home built in 1842 in east-central Alabama. The quilt collection was stored away in the attic at Cedar Heights without the family's awareness of what they had. It is a magnificent story, accented by an extraordinary wealth of family records and quiltmakers' personal histories.
